- III. Using the budget and activity from the last two fiscal years (2018-2019 and 2019-2020), the board went through the budget item by item. When discussing roads, the board made it a goal to put in a new sewer line on Howard Rd from the city limits to just past Lears Rd. The new road would be a cost associated with putting in a new sewer line, rather than a cost to the roads. The board also discussed the desire to make the intersection of Pickerel Lake and 131 safer. We will be looking into some solutions this year.
- IV. In regards to wages, the board would like to give a 2% raise to the trustee's salary, a 3% raise to the assessor, supervisor, treasurer and building department secretary's salary, and to make the clerk a full-time position by combining the salary and giving a 4% raise. The board would also like to raise the per diem for committee meetings to \$60. This would apply to all boards, including the Planning Commission, Parks and Recreation Committee, Sewer Authority, Board of Review, Fire Board, and per diems for the board. Additionally, the board would like to give a 4% raise to the secretary, deputy clerk, and deputy treasurer.
