Separate Tax Limitation Proposal

Shall separate tax limitations be established for a period of four (4) years, 2021 through 2024, inclusive, or until altered by the voters of the County, for the County of Emmet, the Townships, and the Intermediate School District within the County, the aggregate of which shall not exceed 7.8 mills, as follows:

Fire and Medical First Responder Millage Renewal Proposal

Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitations imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Bear Creek Township, of 0.5 mills (\$0.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to 0.4886 mills (\$0.4886 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed at and increased up to the original voted 0.5 mills (\$0.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for 4 years, 2020 through 2023 inclusive, for the purposes of Fire and Medical First Responder protection, raising an estimated \$240,000 in the first year the millage is levied.

Library Services Millage Renewal Proposal

Shall the expired previous authorized increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Bear Creek Township, of 0.4 mills (\$0.40 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced by required "Headlee" millage rollbacks to 0.3908 mills (\$0.3908 per \$1,000 of taxable value), be renewed and increased to the original voted 0.4 mills (\$0.40 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for 4 years, 2020 through 2023 inclusive, for the purpose of obtaining library services for township taxpayers and residents. The proceeds of the millage shall only be used for the operations of the Petoskey District Library and shall not be used to service debt. A 0.4 mill renewal and increase up to the original voted 0.4 mills (\$0.40 per \$1,000 of taxable value) will raise an estimated \$192,564 in the first year the millage is levied, which will be disbursed to the Petoskey District Library or its successor for operations as the Township Board determines appropriate.
